# NOTICE OF ANNUAL SCHOOL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given by the undersigned Clerk of **HIGHWOOD K12 SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 4, CHOUTEAU** County, State of Montana that the Annual School Election will be held on **Tuesday, May 7, 2019**, at the following polling place(s):

**HIGHWOOD PUBLIC SCHOOL  
160 WEST STREET SOUTH  
HIGHWOOD, MT**

Electors will consider the following issues at the election:

- **ONE (1) TRUSTEE** to be elected for a Three (3) year term
- **MILL LEVY PROPOSITION** to finance the school's General Fund:  
Shall the board of trustees be authorized to impose an increase in local taxes to support the general fund in the amount of **THREE THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT & 07/100 DOLLARS (\$3698.07 )** per year which is approximately **2.35 MILLS**, for the purpose of providing additional funds in the K-12 district general fund for the operation and maintenance of the District for the 2019-20 school year?

Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$3.17 and on a home with a market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$6.35 . The durational limit of the levy is permanent once approved by the voters, assuming the district levies that amount at least once in the next five years.

on the day of the election.**

A qualified registered elector who will be unable to go to the polls on the day of election may request an Application for **Absentee Voter's Ballot** from the school district clerk/election administrator's office located at:

If you miss this regular registration deadline (30 days prior to the election), you may still register for the election by showing up at the county election office up to and including on election day. Between noon and the close of business on the day before election day, you may complete and submit a voter registration card, but you will need to return to the district voting location on election day to pick up and vote a ballot.
